**Message from Community Lay Director,
Dusty LaNoue**

As I type these words, we are already into the 3rd week of the new year. How are those resolutions doing? Mine are, well, not getting off the ground as I had hoped. Yes, we have made it to the gym; but not 3 times per week as we wanted. However, we will persevere and keep working at it. My other resolution, was not made at the very beginning of January. It was a suggestion in a devotion that we read in the second week of January. I don't remember the name of the author, but I will explain it to you as I remember it and am using it. It is a one word resolution. The author for this year has chosen the word Flow. There are scriptures that talk about the crystal waters that flow from the throne of God, but there are many things that Flow from our Lord on a daily basis, ie His love, His protection, His spirit, His guidance, etc.

The author challenged the reader to choose their own one word for the year and to use it throughout the day as their resolution. Bill and I are praying for 30, because a few always have to fall off. If either of the walks do not have at least 20 pilgrims confirmed, that walk will be cancelled.

The deadline for the October walks is August 15th.

We all know how the enemy is always fighting against us, because Emmaus is such a gift to those who attend. Our weapons are prayer for guidance and obedience to that guidance - action. You know if you don't have time to do all that has to be done for a chosen pilgrim you can enlist your group brothers and sisters to help, but one person or couple are the "official" sponsors.
