A Note from our Community Spiritual Director

Dear Friends,

So much happens on our Walk weekends. Many of us have particular highlights that we recall and then we also have to admit there are some blank spots in the weekend that we don't recall until someone else mentions it. I confess, I have served on several Walk team since my pilgrim walk and I honestly don't recall any of the images that my table created for our posters, but I recall talking about each one and that they made sense at the time.

Do you recall the very first talk of the Emmaus weekend? We talked about priorities in our lives. Did you notice that it is the only talk that does not mention God? I have heard many tables discuss this talk and I have seen a lot of posters about it, but each time I think about it or hear it again I am reminded that I have to focus on my priorities daily, or soon they are no longer priorities. The world, our jobs, our families, our friends; each presents priorities to fill the void when we do not have our priorities set, and they will set our priorities for us if we permit them.

Can you imagine not setting your mortgage payment as a priority? Likewise, can you foresee not setting rest as a priority - pretty soon your body will make it a priority! Billy Graham, among several others, once made the statement, "show me your checkbook and I can tell you your priorities." Today we'd have to look at a bank statement because fewer and fewer people are using checks; then consider Google-Pay or Apple-Pay or PayPal or Venmo or... I don't know, there are many more options out there. Whatever mechanism, though, the adage is still true, we spend our time and money on those things that are important to us.

The world is slowly recovering from COVID-19. We'd like to think it is over, but the reality is that there are people going to the hospitals again, having pneumonia again, and again there are some who are dying from this disease. It is here to stay. It may not be as virulent as when it first struck in 2020, but it is still a virus and still making people sick. The world was not prepared for this epidemic and many businesses closed their doors permanently because they did not have the financial resources to survive through the mandated shutdowns. Your Arizona Emmaus Board was no more prepared than many other organizations, and yet through excellent leadership, drastic reduction of expenses, and God's grace, the dollars have managed to last. The Arizona Walk to Emmaus is now planning two Walk weekends (a Men's Walk and a Women's Walk) in February 2024. Generous gifts are going to cover some of the largest bills. We know others will likely be made by people like you who make sharing God's message of love through this ministry a priority in their lives.

Today I think we re doing a better job of prioritizing time relaxing, being with friends and family, and doing things we enjoy. Employers have repeatedly expressed frustration about getting employees who are "committed to their jobs" (i.e. willing to give up family time and time off to work for free). But I have to ask, because church attendance trends indicate fewer people are attending church, is God still your priority? Are you spending time with God and in God's service? Are you supporting God's ministries through the church with your time, your gifts, your knowledge, your skills, your whole heart? Are going to be like one of those bridesmaids Jesus told about who was not prepared when the groom arrived? Christ is alive in the world today and you can help ensure God's message is shared. Consider how you can help the Arizona Walk to Emmaus and send your financial gift, sign up to show your interest in serving, and pray for the Walk to Emmaus. Then know that you are loved and God has blessed you to be able to help in such a time as this.

From the Treasurer

For 2022, our income was \$14,125.46 and our expenses were \$19,370.74, for a net loss of \$5245.28 which came out of savings. For 2023 from January 1 to August 31 our income is \$2371.45 and our expenses are \$7539.59, for a net loss of \$5168.14, which came from savings. As of September 13, 2023 we have \$4888. total in checking and savings.

We have minimum expected expenses from September to December of \$1300.00, which is reasonable. However, January we have expected expenses of \$7780. This would be for insurance, storage, initial checks for the Flagstaff walks, head cook checks for the Sun City Walks. In addition, the refrigerated truck needs new tires, especially before going to Flagstaff and 3 Day needs additional replacement supplies for an estimated total \$1200. Team fees for February will largely be received by January. However Pilgrim fees are largely paid on Thursday of the Walk.
