GROUPING

On the third day of your Walk you participated in an informal session on Grouping. You were given a double-sided card to keep you on track in your spiritual Walk with Christ and to serve as an informal agenda for your weekly Grouping session. These sessions can be held at a local coffee shop, restaurant or a member's home, wherever is most comfortable for your group. Ideally your small group will be made up of several members from previous Walks and new community members just off their first Walk.

The card is two-sided and intended to fold up to the size of a business card that you can carry in your wallet or purse. One side lists elements of your spiritual life, your study and your action. The other side has the Prayer to the Holy Spirit and a general list of suggested points of accountability to discuss each week, although it is not necessary to hit each point every week.


The card is a general guide for your weekly grouping but is not intended as a strict regimen. Some of the points are:

- Closest to Christ At what point during the week did you feel closest to Christ?
- · Call to Discipleship Did you experience a call to discipleship and what did you do?
- Discipleship Denied Was there a time when you feel you should have done something to share the love
 of Christ...... but didn't. And make a commitment to do better next time.

Take time to ask each member of the group for special prayer concerns. I like to carry a notepad to write these down to include in my daily prayers. And each weekly grouping should end with the Prayer of Thanksgiving.

In this way we help our Grouping sisters and brothers to hold each other accountable in our renewed Walk with Christ. And as we grow in our faith we can serve as guides to others we encounter in our daily walk.
