CALLING ALL SPONSORS - FYI

1. Invitations are sent out 2 and a half to 3 months prior to the Walk weekends.
2. The earlier the application is received, the better the chance your Pilgrim will have a spot on the weekend.
3. On the application, your Pilgrim needs to confirm they have been baptized, have the applications signed by their pastor and have a sponsor named.
4. Please put the sponsor's address on the application.
5. Encourage husband and wife to attend. If one will not, have their pastor send a note explaining that it won't be a problem.
6. Explain the follow-up program of group reunions and Gatherings to your Pilgrim.
7. After an invitation is received, follow up with your Pilgrim to make sure they have sent back their response indicating if they will be attending the Walk.
8. The invitation the Pilgrim receives confirms their spot on the weekend. No additional communication is sent to them.



9. Sponsor information is mailed out after a "yes" response is received.
10. The names in the Rooster Tales are not always current, because of the printing deadline.
11. Out of state sponsors need a co-sponsor in Arizona.
12. If you attended a Walk in another state, please attend the training to learn about sponsoring in Arizona.

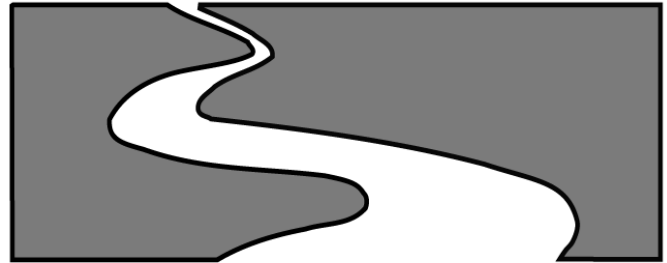
