WHAT IS KAIROS PRISON MINISTRY?

Kairos Prison Ministry is an inter-denominational, all-volunteer Christian prison ministry that utilizes the Cursillo method, upon which the Walk to Emmaus program is based, to bring Christ's love and presence to prison inmates and their families. The word "Kairos" means "God's Special Time", and that is what a Kairos weekend is in the life of those inmates and family members who attend the weekends all across the country and around the world. It is also a special time for team members as they see the transforming power of the Holy Spirit at work in the lives of the participants.

Kairos uses 3 separate programs in its ministry: Kairos Inside, ministering to both men and women who are incarcerated; Kairos Outside, ministering to female family members of the incarcerated; and Kairos Torch, ministering to youthful offenders of both sexes. While the formats and weekend schedules are different, the results are the same: changed lives.

Here in Arizona, God is using Kairos Inside to change the lives of inmates in a prison in Florence, and the lives of female family members through Kairos Outside weekends held in Tucson. Both programs hold two weekends per year, so there are four opportunities each year for interested people to hear firsthand at the closings what the weekends have meant to the participants.

But the impact of Kairos doesn't stop with the end of the weekend, because the Kairos programs include reunions and retreats throughout the year, leading to the Kairos volunteers sometimes being known in the prisons as "the ones who come back"! In the Florence prison, there is a Kairos event scheduled for every week of the year.

Because Kairos uses the Cursillo method in its ministry, team members must have experienced a 4th Day weekend (Cursillo, Walk to Emmaus, Via de Cristo or Tres Dias) themselves, be active participants in a reunion group, and be active in their churches and 4th Day communities.
