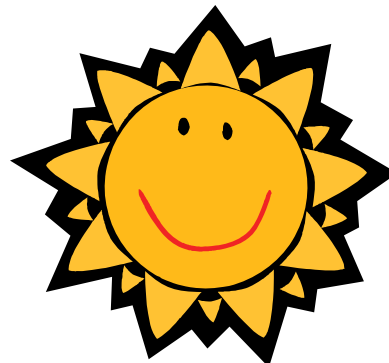

I wish you enough pain so that even the smallest of joys in life may appear bigger.

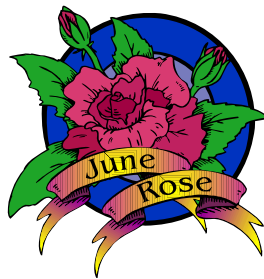
I wish you enough gain to satisfy your wanting.
