April Walks - Directions

The April Walks will be held at St. Paul's UMC, 8051 E. Broadway Blvd., Tucson, AZ (on east side).

Take I10 to Congress/Broadway exit east, and cross town to St. Paul's on east Broadway just after Kolb Road, Pantano Road, and the bridge over Pantano Wash, on the left as you go up a hill. Turn left at the eastern edge of St. Paul's onto McGuire Street and then left into the parking lot. A good landmark is the Fellowship Square Apartments on the left side of Broadway; turn left just before the apartments. (Speedway is a good alternate street from I-10; take it to the east side of town, turn right onto Kolb road, left onto Broadway and continue as above.)

From I-10 east, take Kolb Road to Broadway, turn right and proceed as above or take Houghton to Broadway and turn left, watch for Camino Seco and then turn right into St. Paul's at McGuire, just after the Fellowship Square Apartments.

From I-19 and the south, take your favorite shortcut to East Broadway (Kolb is good) and go east to St. Paul's.
