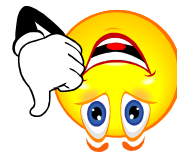
## CHRYSLIS FLIGHTS NEED YOUR HELP!

Did you notice that it said that the AZ Walk to Emmaus community and the Chrysalis community are one and the same? It is, and that may be news to some of you. If you go to the Arizona Walk to Emmaus/Chrysalis Website, you will find information about both Walks and Flights. The same is true of the Rooster Tales. It is a newsletter for the whole Walk to Emmaus and Chrysalis community in Arizona. We are one big, joyful community ready to serve. So, if you are trained, you can serve on Walks to Emmaus or Chrysalis Flights. Flights are for 16- to 21-year-old young men and women. We have had 33 Flights in Arizona, but not too many in the past few years. Chrysalis needs OUR HELP to get Flights going again each year. Michaëlle Ford has been appointed Community Lay Director for our Chrysalis Board, and has others willing and ready to serve with her on that board. She needs a few more, though; so if you want to serve, let her know. Flights will take place all over the community, just like Walks do. We had Flight 33 in Tucson last summer, so the next Flight will probably be somewhere else in our community, either the Phoenix/metropolitan area, Flagstaff, or other areas in our state/community. No matter where you live, you can serve on Flights. They need us to serve on the weekend, make agape, make food, be at their Candlelight and Closing services, etc. Your AZ Walk to Emmaus Board is ready to serve in any way we can to help the Chrysalis Community. Michaëlle is actually a representative of Chrysalis on our board, too.

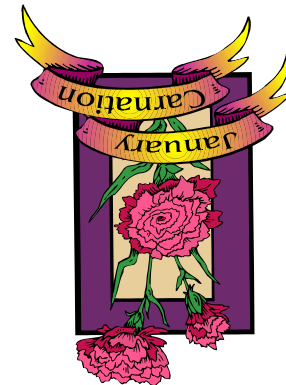
