Can You Help Us?

If you are sponsoring someone on a Walk, please be sure to fill out the application completely. includes the questions regarding special needs. Please thoughtfully talk this over with your pilgrim(s). Our cook teams are amazing. They can plan for and be ready for all kinds of situations if they know in advance what to expect. Does your pilgrim have special needs? Diet? Medications needed at a specific time? Are they able to walk between the Emmaus room and the Sanctuary or will they need help? Do they need special sleeping arrangements? When the team doesn't find out until Thursday night at send-off, it places a heavy burden on them. If you need more space than allowed on the application, please type or write an extra page and attach it. Be as specific and detailed as may seem necessary in order for the team to prepare for those particular needs. The better you prepare the team for your pilgrim and their needs, the better the team can serve your pilgrim on the weekend. Thanks for your help in this matter. May God bless our sponsors.

Scholarships Available


During these difficult economic times, we remind our community members that if they choose to sponsor a pilgrim who cannot afford the cost of the weekend.

Perhaps this might apply to you, someone considering being a sponsor. Or someone praying about serving as a team member. Please remember that scholarships are available to those who need them. Please say something to the Registrar when sponsoring someone if assistance is needed. Please mention to the Lay Director of the team or the ALD who is in charge of collecting team fees. Don't just ignore the situation. Speak to someone letting them know you need financial assistance.

Each person serving on a team that needs a scholarship will be provided with one. But please do not abuse the program. Often, there are 6 team meetings preparing that

team for the weekend. If you offer to pay just \$10 at each meeting towards the cost of the weekend, which is now \$60, you would have

BANNERS

If you are sponsoring a pilgrim on a Walk, please be sure to have their banner delivered when you deliver your pilgrim on Thursday.

Remember that all banners are to be no larger than 24" by 36" and

are not to be framed.

Dowel rods or other means of hanging the banner should be used. This makes it easier for hanging banners for display and follows the guidelines for continuity. Please adhere to these guidelines.

Sponsor's Hour

If you are sponsoring a Pilgrim on a Walk, please be sure to stay for the Sponsor's Hour after the team and pilgrims are called out of the chapel or sanctuary.

This is the time when you are able to pray over the cross that your pilgrim will receive on Sunday. Don't miss this wonderful experience by leaving to go home too early. Someone will pray over the cross, but it should be YOU!


