It's about Relationships

As Mike, Rob, and I met for our weekly reunion group (Bill and Jim were under the weather and not with us that day), we began to share about folks who might be struggling at Christmas time as they remembered family and friends no longer around. Those relationships now exist only in their memory of days past. But it is those cherished relationships which have value.

The Bible is filled with stories, beginning to end, of God's desire for a lasting relationship with humankind. God established a relationship Adam and Eve. And another relationship with Noah. And another with Abraham and Moses. And so on throughout Hebrew history, creating relationships and then recreating them after they were broken. And finally God established a new relationship with us through Christ Jesus that we cling to today.

Relationships are part of the core values of the Walk To Emmaus. And it starts with the relationship between sponsor and pilgrims. Whether family or friend, someone at work or someone in choir, personal relationships enable us to start a conversation, "Want to know more about the Walk To Emmaus?" And it is those relationships which can conclude with, "How about we sponsor the two of you on the next set of weekends? It would be a blessing to us."

We establish new or rekindle old relationships when a weekend team is called together. The Leadership Team often meets four or five times prior to the first full team meeting to build their relationships. Then the team relationships becomes stronger through shared experiences, so we ask all talk team members to attend each meeting and Cooks to attend as many as possible in preparation of serving the Pilgrims. Table relationships with your partner can key meaningful table conversations following each talk. And remember the valuable relationships Cooks share with one another as they prepare meals, deliver agape, or wash the dishes. All of these relationships add value and meaning to the weekend. These strong team relationships can translate to deeper relationships with Pilgrims as the weekend progresses. And eventually these weekend relationships can lead to a truer relationship with God through Christ Jesus.

May 2015 be the year all of your relationships grow stronger and more meaningful.

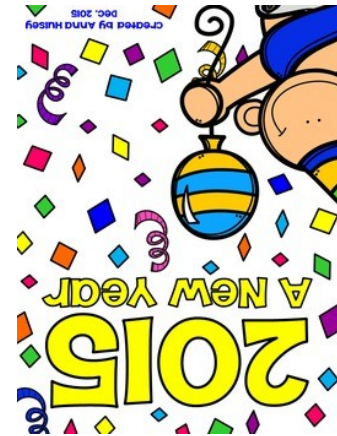
