

Communique from Community Lay Director, Wally Athey

Our history directs our future

Many of you recall hearing or reading about The Walk to Emmaus history, including our own Arizona Walk. Our expression started in 1985 and that's why we're celebrating our 30th anniversary on Saturday, October 24 at Central UMC in Phoenix.

But the earlier history is important too. Our roots go back to the Roman Catholic Cursillo movement in 1949 in Spain. The first Cursillo in the U.S. was held in Waco, Texas in 1957. Twenty years later in 1977, the Upper Room conducted two model weekends in Peoria, Illinois that April and May. A few years later, this ecumenical model proved to be an effective tool in energizing disciples for ministry in local congregations, as well as creating spiritual renewal among participants. The movement began to grow.

A 1981 mutual agreement led to a separation from the Catholic Cursillo and the creation of the Upper Room's Walk to Emmaus mission of equipping knowledgeable church leaders with vital piety. Just a year before we were birthed here in Arizona, a Walk was held in Australia making the movement international.

This short history lesson helps us today as we look to the future. The Walk to Emmaus International movement has grown, has matured, has changed, and is constantly evolving. A recent message from the Upper Room announced, "As we've continued to offer these programs [Emmaus and Chrysalis], we have seen the need to reach more people with appropriate life stage offerings. As a result, this year we will launch Face to Face for adults who are 60 and older, and, in 2016, we will introduce Journey to the Table for young adults between the ages of 18 and 35. The development of new programs and the rebranding of the existing ones bring us, not only to design logos for the new offerings, but also to update the existing ones."

Who's on board for the future? Great opportunities lie ahead. "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will make you fishers of men." [Matt 4:19 NIV]

How Did "They" Get on the Walk?! (Part 1)

Your Board of Directors has both the duty and privilege of overseeing the three day weekends in Arizona along with the resulting 4th Day activities. The Emmaus Community in Arizona and the board members (who come from that community) are all tasked with maintaining a spiritual program that has no equal throughout the world. Ask anyone who has been on a recent walk in Arizona and they will say, "It was the BEST WALK EVER!" Perhaps that attitude is why we have a passionate community and passionate board members. We are not knocking any other community, we are saying that whenever the Holy Spirit shows up, it's the 'best ever'.

However, that same attitude has the potential to tear us away from the understanding of what we are about. So I ask the question, "What is the desired outcome at the end of a weekend?"

One board member recently said, "The Emmaus program as I perceived it is about building leadership within the church." Given that a board member stated that, I would assume that it is a common held idea within the Emmaus Community. However, careful examination of material from The Upper Room, Walk to Emmaus headquarters, points to something else.

Go to the website for Walk to Emmaus at emmaus.upperroom.org/about and you will see an article called, "A Journey with Christ." The second paragraph of that article says, "The Walk to Emmaus experience begins with the prayerful discernment and invitation from a sponsor."

Notice that the 'experience' does not begin with the weekend. It does not begin with an Agape Feast, a touching letter, or a candlelight service. The 'experience' begins with "prayerful discernment." That's because it is God who calls the pilgrim, not a well-intentioned sponsor.

Don't do someone a disservice. . . (more to come next time.)
