Purpose of Emmaus

The focus of Emmaus is God as known in Jesus Christ, and how that finds expression in the local church. The Walk to Emmaus seeks to inspire, challenge and then equip church leaders for Christian action in their homes, churches, places of work and communities. Emmaus lifts up a way for our grace-filled lives to be lived and shared with others.

What is the Walk to Emmaus?

The Gospel of Luke tells the story of two friends travelling on the road from Jerusalem to Emmaus, sharing their hearts deepest concerns about the death of their Savior. The risen Christ joined them and explained the scriptures as they walked, and how it was ordained the Christ should suffer and so enter His glory. They did not recognize Him until at the end of their journey, they invited Him to stay and dine with them. It was then they recognized Him as the risen Christ, and they rushed back to Jerusalem to tell the others.

(Luke 24:13-15)

The Walk to Emmaus is a 72-hour experience beginning on Thursday evening and ending on Sunday evening. It is a highly structured weekend designed to strengthen and renew the faith of Christians. At Emmaus you will spend three busy but enjoyable days in a retreat setting, living and studying together in song, prayer, worship and discussion.

Discussions center around 15 talks given by clergy and laity, all representing a theme of God's grace and love. You will have the opportunity to participate in the daily celebration of Holy Communion and begin to understand more fully the presence of Christ in the body of believers.

What happens after Emmaus?

One of the primary strengths of Emmaus is the follow-up. Your weekend only lasts three days but you are invited to build on it for the rest of your life, through expanding your spiritual life in study and congregational participation, meeting in regular small groups (Group reunions), and community gatherings.
